

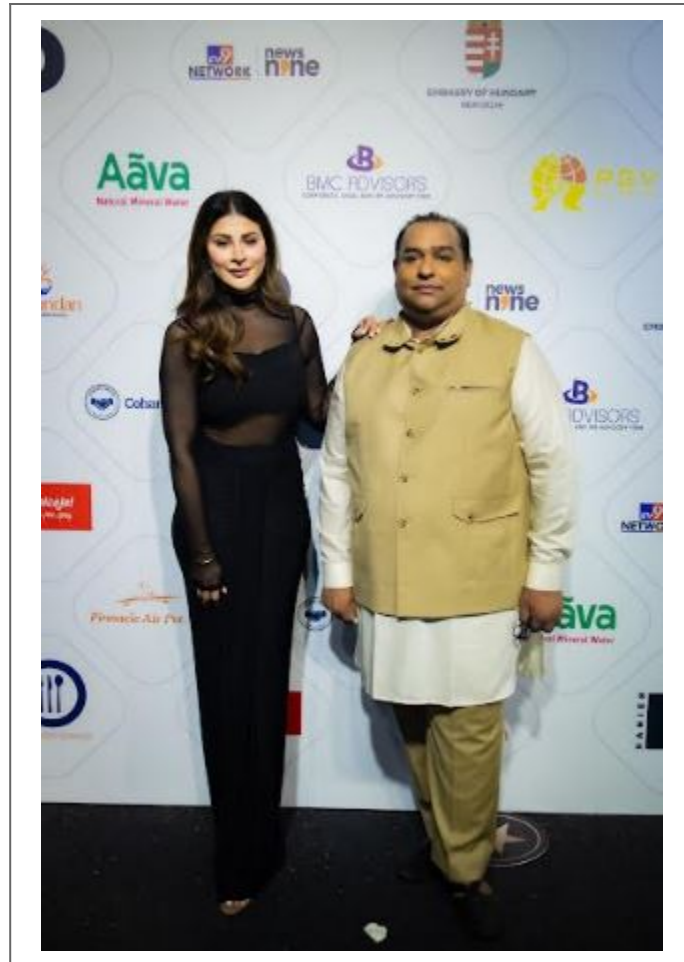
Grand Trailer Launch of Mrs Cosmos India (MCOI) at the Embassy of Hungary
